Registration: Registration will be between 2:00pm and 2:30pm on Thursday afternoon at the Patterson Hall. Lunch is not provided.

When you turn onto Bull Street, you will drive up a very steep hill. As you come up the hill you will see parking garages on your left-hand side. Park in the garage to unload and register for camp, Patterson Hall is just across the street from the parking garage.

We will have staff out there to help guide you also!

Daily Drop Off and Pick Up Times for Commuters (not staying in dorms): Drop off by 9:00am and Pick up is at 8:45pm at Stone Soccer Stadium. Lunch and dinner are provided, but breakfast is not provided for commuter campers.

Drop Off and Pick Up on First and Last Day for Residential Campers (staying in dorms): 2pm on the first day and 12pm on the last day

What to Bring: Soccer cleats, shin guards, sneakers, water bottle, sun screen, backpack, linens, towel, soccer clothes, regular clothes, shower shoes, toiletries, sleeping bag and pillow. There are three total sessions a day, so bring enough to wear for that amount of training.

Meals: Meals are provided through the University Dining Services at Preston Dining Hall.

We also have pizza parties and order sandwiches from local sandwich shops as well. Meals will be provided starting with dinner on the first night of camp and ending with breakfast on the final day of camp.

Camp ball: Campers will receive a camp ball on the first day of camp

Cancellation/Refund Policy: All requests for refunds must be made in writing; verbal cancellations/refund requests will not be honored. The following refund policy applies to all camps or clinics listed in the camp guide unless otherwise specified:

Residential/Team and Early ID: Cancellation and/or request for refunds received at least two weeks prior to the start of camp may receive a 50% refund, minus a non-refundable administrative fee.

Medical Circumstances/Injury: If there is a medical circumstance occurring before/after the above said deadline(s) and a medical doctor, states it is unsafe and/or will do more harm to the player to

participate from a pre-existing injury and/or surgery or an injury sustained recently, therefore preventing the camper's participation - a note signed by the medical doctor can be sent to camp director and the following refunds are applicable:

Residential/Team and Residential Early ID: 50% refund applied, minus a non-refundable administrative fee.

Camp Credit: Campers will also have the choice to apply their registration to a future camp (camp credit) to a future camp of their choice; camp credit must be used within one camp season year of application (i.e. Summer 2018-Summer 2019). Once placed into camp credit, you have one calendar year to choose a future camp of your choice; there are no refunds available once placed into camp credit. However, if you have chosen a future camp, you sustain an injury leading into the selected camp, and the medical circumstances/injury policy can be applied (see above) we can apply an extension to a future camp. Should this happen you have one camp season year to use this credit.

Carolina Soccer School holds the right to refund the full amount of the registration fee to campers under certain circumstances (*i.e. inclement weather/natural disasters causing travel cancellations, death in the family, illnesses in the family causing travel issues*).

Carolina Soccer School reserves the right to change and/or cancel any camp at any time for any reason, at which time a full refund will be honored.
